Originally founded in 2000 as Metropolitan Fine Arts Center, MSA transitioned to non-profit status in 2013. MSA now serves more than 700 students and produces over 75 performances each year. MSA is located in Alexandria, Va. and is equipped with 8 state of the art dance studios, 5 music studios, an academic wing and a black box theater.

We achieve excellence in arts and academic education through a unique approach to teaching and learning. Our methodology encourages a nurturing, supportive and inspiring culture where students earn the confidence to work towards their highest potential. Students are free to take risks, make changes and learn from their experiences while doing so. We strive to be a world-class center for cultivating excellence in the arts through professional training, top-notch faculty, and by educating our community on the significant impacts of the arts.

MSA serves people of all ages, backgrounds, and abilities, providing opportunities for creative expression, education and audience awareness in all of these art forms. 
PROGRAMS
